An Appeal to Help with our Major Refurbishment and Revitalisation Project

As you will have seen in the press recently, the plans for the refurbishment of St Nicholas Church have now received the formal permissions needed to go ahead. With tender documents being sent out this week, the church is now aiming for a start date in mid May.

Grants have been received from a number of trusts, with more applications pending, and the church family themselves have now pledged almost £90,000 towards the cost of the work. Together these now mean that around 80% of the money has been secured.

To help bridge the gap in funding, the Friends of St Nicholas Stevenage Trust is organising an **Auction of Promises** to be held on **Saturday 13th April**, as part of the Church's Easter Fun Day. We already have some notable lots, including a visit to the House of Commons with tea with our MP, a flight in a light aircraft, gym membership, piano lessons and a personal flower arranging course, to name but a few.
