October 2022

It is with great joy that we can confirm that the Parish Profile is now completed and was signed off by both PCCs on the 24th September. Immediately following this meeting, we had the pre-vacancy meeting with Archdeacon Janet (Archdeacon of Hertford) where she discussed the interview process with both PCCs. We also agreed our advertisement for the new Rector at the same meeting.

The Advertisement is out now! It is in the Church Times for three weeks commencing on Friday 30th September and will also be on the diocesan website along with the Church Profile, which you can also see on our own website. We are also advertising with the Church Society and with ReNew.

So where do we go from here? The closing date of the advert is 26th October at 12 noon. Short-listing will take place on the 7th November and the interviews will take place on 30th November. Bishop Alan, the local Archdeacon, Rural Dean and four parish representatives will interview the candidates. There will be a maximum of four candidates on the day and the interview process will be concluded on the same day.

The most important thing that we should be doing now is to pray. Pray that God is calling the Rector for our churches, and they would be hearing that call and they will answer that call. Ask God that he would give wisdom and discernment to those who will be shortlisting and interviewing the candidates.

We need prayers for both churches that as we go through the interregnum, we will keep worshipping and praying together and looking after one another and also going out with the Gospel. As Paul says in Philippians 4v6, "Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God."

There are plenty of opportunities to pray together this month - please see the "Come and pray together" section in this month's Herald; there are different times that we can pray, and we do not have to pray out loud, we can pray silently, or we can use prayers that have been written down.

At this time, let's continue to grow spiritually. So being at church is important, as is praying, reading the Bible, and also by being in a home group if you're able.

We need to be praying for the preachers coming to both churches that they will preach the word faithfully, uphold the truth and as that word goes out week by week it will change lives, and that God will be adding those who are his to his kingdom and renewing our faith.

Do start praying now for all our Christmas events! We will shortly be planning for these. We know that we will not be able to run all the Christmas services that we normally do. We will still plan for a carol service, Christingle service, and we hope to go back into Truro and Norman Courts to sing carols there. And it's great we have been contacted by several schools who want to hold services in St Nicholas church. There will also be our Ladies Christmas event and some others in the pipeline, so watch this space! And pray!
