Two thousand years ago, a devout man in the Jerusalem Temple saw a baby and sang out:

"Now, according to your word, Sovereign Lord, permit your servant to depart in peace. For my eyes have seen your salvation that you have prepared in the presence of all peoples: a light, for revelation to the Gentiles, and for glory to your people Israel."

The man was Simeon and the baby he had seen was Jesus Christ. Simeon knew that the baby he had seen was not like all the others being presented in the Temple that day by joyful parents, but instead was nothing less than the saviour of God's people.

Simeon's prophetic word was of such richness that the church took it as the canticle (song) to follow the New Testament reading daily at compline (night prayer).

We also particularly remember both Simeon and Anna and their heralding of the 'consolation of Israel' each year at Candlemas (2 Feb). May we all this Candlemas, with Simeon, be ready (whenever our time comes) to 'depart in peace', knowing our salvation.


OTHER EVENTS COMING UP
