So what do we make of Psalm 15 saying:

[Q] O LORD... Who shall dwell on your holy hill?

[A] He who walks blamelessly and does what is right and speaks truth in his heart

Blamelessly! Wow. Only the 'blameless' will dwell on God's holy hill (i.e. with him in heaven). "That counts me out", most of us would say, when we are being honest.

Thankfully, there is one person who it does not count out – Jesus Christ. Good news for him.

Even more thankfully, another Psalm promises "Blessed are all who take refuge in him" (Psalm 2:12). Good news for all of us! We might not be blameless, but so long as we trust in Jesus we can enjoy all the benefits of his blamelessness ourselves. Praise the Lord!
